

This month's cover picture comes from a special "newspaper" that Triumph produced to celebrate world speed record achievement at Bonneville Salt Flats in 1956. Last year was the 60th Anniversary of that event and the only commemoration of it that I can recall was the limited edition T214 Bonneville (see right).

The Triumph Owners celebrated the speed record's 40th anniversary in 1996 with an event at the National Motorcycle Museum – the record breaking machine being the centrepiece.

The club waited 13 years to celebrate the 50th anniversary – that's because we focussed on the introduction of the Pannoville model range rather


Next day was easy one, messing around and both recovering.
