

Membership Renewals

If your club membership is due for renewal here are the best ways of dealing with it...

- 1) Renew on-line via tomcc.org/Home/Membership with a credit card, debit card or PayPal account. You can also get a £2 discount using this method.
- 2) Fill in the membership form that was sent to you, then post it direct to the HQ Membership address at Horley, as shown on the form. Include a cheque made payable to Triumph Owners MCC.
- 3) Fill in the membership form and hand it to the Branch Membership Secretary at a club night. Payment by cheque or cash. Memberships renewed this way are only sent to HQ a couple of times a month, so will take longer to process than 1 or 2 above.

Don't worry about the money as the Branch receives the same amount per person regardless of the method used to renew.

Odds & Sods

Should I wear earplugs?

1 in 6 Britons have some form of hearing loss, over 6m people have tinnitus!.

According to Doctors you should wear earplugs if you are going to ride at over 35mph. At 65mph wind noise can easily reach 103db. In the work place you must have ear protection at anything above 80db!. So you can see that even relatively minor speeds wind noise inside the Helmet can be significant.

Earplugs also reduce fatigue. Wind noise can cause fatigue and tiredness without you knowing it! Any protection is better than none; also make sure your helmet is a good fit.
